Moreland has also announced the opening acts for his upcoming 2020 tour dates, where he’ll be joined by Justin Peter Kinkel-Schuster, S.G. Goodman and Will Johnson as he travels from the Southeast to the West Coast during April and May of next year. He will be accompanied on stage by multi-instrumentalist/vocalist John Calvin Abney.

Produced by Matt Pence (Jason Isbell, The Breeders, Sarah Jaffe) and recorded at The Echo Lab, *LP5* marks the first time that Moreland has worked with an outside producer. Though Moreland has long possessed the ability to quiet a noisy room with nothing but his voice, songs, and a guitar, the elevated production of the new album takes Moreland’s lyrical mastery to a stunning new level. Special guests on the album include Pence on drums, Bonnie Whitmore on bass/vocals and Moreland’s talented band-mate John Calvin Abney on a variety of instruments.
