**THE BAND OF HEATHENS'S *STRANGER* OUT TODAY**

Nashville, TN – Today, The Band of Heathens will gather together and perform live from The Finishing School recording studio in Austin, TX to celebrate the release of their new critically-acclaimed album *Stranger*. Since the Covid19 pandemic hit, the Heathens have been performing via Zoom on their Tuesday night [Good Time Supper Club](#) show, each in their homes around the country from Los Angeles to Austin to Nashville to Asheville. While unable to tour, The Band of Heathens have made the most of the livestream experience. In addition to their Tuesday night series, the band have been offering private shows to their fans. Featured in an NBCNews.com piece about musicians pivoting during the pandemic, frontman Gordy Quist said, "What we lack in rock 'n' roll energy, we make up for in intimacy and humor." "The concerts and other streaming shows we do help bridge a gap and keep a roof over our heads."

The Band of Heathens commitment to staying engaged with their fans virtually continues to make them leaders in the 2020 music space. The group has found yet another new way to flex their innovative and creative muscles; by utilizing Spotify's new Canvas video feature to further tell the story of *Stranger*. Inspired by a space cowboy character created by renowned graphic artist Alan Forbes (The Black Crowes, Queens of the Stone Age) for an album release poster, the band engaged animator Josh Clark to create an animated story via video. The narrative shows the character coming to planet earth, taking a ride through the current landscape before escaping back to another universe. By streaming the entire album on Spotify, fans can watch the story unfold between all the songs.

The band is earning raves for *Stranger*. *American Songwriter* said, "...*Stranger* speaks volumes, and, in turn, beckons us all to listen." *PopMatters* claimed, "... the quality of the

songs is greatly enhanced by the performances. This is a group with five vocalists who understand the importance of harmony. “

The Band of Heathens recorded *Stranger* with Tucker Martine (The Decemberists, My Morning Jacket) in Portland, OR. With Martine at the helm, *Stranger* emphasizes songcraft and intricate arrangements set in a spacious sonic landscape that reinvents the band’s sound. The songs teem with the emotion borne of personal experience, as has been The Band of Heathens’ method from the very start. *Stranger* moves off into a new place, but still echoes the group’s artful songwriting and multi-layered narrative observations. Martine’s influence amplifies the unique voice that The Band of Heathens has created throughout their celebrated career, making *Stranger* their most engaging release thus far.
