Nashville, TN – Amigo the Devil has released the new lyric video for his haunting and introspective song "Virtue and Vitriol." The clip is a slow-moving close up that pans across the ashes and warped metal that remains following a fire that engulfed and completely burned out a car. That vehicle happened to be a vintage car collector's dream – a custom wrap 1979 Ford Econoline Budweiser van, one of only a handful left in existence today – purchased by Amigo the Devil's Danny Kiranos in 2023.
