# ACCLAIMED SINGER/SONGWRITER DYLAN LEBLANC TO RELEASE COYOTE (EXPANDED EDITION) ON JANUARY 19<sup>TH</sup> TO COINCIDE WITH U.S. TOUR

### <u>EXPANDED EDITION FEATURES FOUR NEW STUDIO ALBUM TRACKS</u> AND FIVE LIVE PERFORMANCES FROM FAME STUDIOS

## NEW SINGLE "LET IT RAIN" OUT TODAY LISTEN HERE

Nashville, TN – Today, celebrated singer/songwriter/multi-instrumentalist Dylan LeBlanc announces the expanded edition of his 2023 album *Coyote*, out January 19<sup>th</sup> via ATO Records. In addition, the first leg of LeBlanc's U.S. tour begins January 17<sup>th</sup> in New Orleans and runs through March. A full list of dates is below and on LeBlanc's website **HERE**.

To commemorate the expanded edition, LeBlanc is releasing "Let It Rain," one of the four new studio tracks from the *Coyote* session that will be available on the extended release. Listen to "Let It Rain" via DSPs <a href="HERE">HERE</a>. Other previously unreleased songs on the expanded edition include "Day By Day," "Fortune Teller," and "Angel." The new version will also feature five live performances recorded during the tracking of *Coyote*.

Coyote is a semi-autobiographical concept album centers on the character of Coyote, a man on the run from his past. On the song "The Crowd Goes Wild," LeBlanc looks outside Coyote's individual journey to explore how people throughout time derive pleasure from another's misfortune. LeBlanc claims, "This song zooms out of the story and explains how people have a love affair with seeing their fellow man get torn apart. It also underscores how the system is designed and rigged against those less fortunate and how hard it is to escape poor circumstances, such as those of Coyote."

Coyote, LeBlanc's first self-produced album, was recorded at the legendary FAME Studios in Muscle Shoals, Alabama. The studio is greatly significant to LeBlanc – located in one of his hometowns, it's not only the studio where he honed his craft as a songwriter and musician, it's also where he watched his father, James LeBlanc, make a career as a songwriter and session player. The rich lyrics on Coyote reflect the wisdom and endurance of a tough childhood split between Texas, Louisiana, and Alabama. But while he has experienced his share of hardships, LeBlanc is an example of how beauty comes from perseverance. His tenacity has paid off in spades, leading him to a record deal with ATO Records, the release of 2019's critically acclaimed Renegade, and now Coyote, which LeBlanc says is the record he has always wanted to make.
